

TEXTILE STUDY GROUP TEACHER'S BURSARY AWARD - 2019

BURSARY AWARD

To be used for personal development and student-based project.
A bursary award of £500 annually for textile teachers.

ELIGIBILITY

Anyone currently teaching textiles and embroidery or any stitch-based subject area and at any level of education.

Can be in full-time, part-time or working as a free-lance teacher.

Must be a permanent resident in the UK.

HOW TO APPLY

Candidates to submit:

A proposal of up to 500 words describing how the bursary will be spent and how it will benefit the applicant in his/her continued teaching and working practice.

Short CV to include qualifications and experience of the last 5 years

8 images: 4 of which reflect the work with his/her pupils and 4 which reflect his/her own work. Images must be dated and labelled with dimensions and include some written details to explain context. We recommend the use of Dropbox or Wetransfer
Images and proposal to be received by **30th November** and submitted on-line only.

SELECTION

This will be made by panel of 3 Textile Study Group members.

The recipient of the reward will be notified no later than **31st January the following year** and the money given alongside the notification.

PRESENTATION

The winner of the award must submit 8 images (with permission to use them for publicity) and a final short report of 300 to 500 words to explain how the award money has been spent and how he/she and his/her students has benefitted from the award.

This is be submitted by **1st September of that year** when the selection panel will give a brief presentation to the Textile Study Group membership.
