

# TEXTILE STUDY GROUP - TEACHERS AWARD

## AWARD

An award of £500 given annually for textile teachers.

The successful applicant will use the award to deliver the proposal as they have set out in the application.

## ELIGIBILITY

We ask the applicant to put together a project which will have an inspiring and positive effect on their students, either by direct or online teaching in a school, college or adult education centre, museum or in an informal setting.

The applicant can be in full-time, part-time or working as a free-lance teacher currently teaching textiles and embroidery or any stitch-based subject area and at any level of education.

They must be a permanent resident in the UK.

## HOW TO APPLY

The applicant is asked to submit a proposal of an inspiring project that they would be keen to offer their students within the up-coming academic year and then present the results in a digital report. This proposal to be outlined in up to 500 words to describe how the award will be spent and how it will benefit the applicant in his/her continued teaching and working practice.

Short CV to include qualifications and experience of the last 5 years.

8 images:

4 of which reflect the work with his/her pupils

4 which reflect his/her own work.

Images must be dated and labelled with dimensions and include some written details to explain context.

We recommend the use of Dropbox or WeTransfer

Images and proposal to be received by **30<sup>th</sup> November** and submitted on-line only.

## SELECTION

This will be made by a panel of three Textile Study Group members.

The award will be given to the applicant who impresses the panel with the most imaginative way of stretching their mind to make creative use of the limitations of their current teaching situation.

The recipient of the reward will be notified no later than **31st January the following year** and presented with the award money in order to carry out their proposal.

## PRESENTATION BY WINNING APPLICANT

By **1st September of that year**, the winner of the award must submit a final short report of 300 to 500 words with up to 8 images (with permission to use them for publicity) to explain how the award money has been spent and how he/she and his/her students has benefitted from the award.

The TSG selection panel will give a brief presentation to the Textile Study Group membership to introduce the winner and the results of the winning project. This will also be added to the Textile Group website.
