Booking information

1. There will be 16 students in each group. The prices below are our best estimate until Hillscourt can confirm their prices later in 2021. We will confirm the final cost to booked students as soon as possible.

£650 Resident: Full board, ensuite bedroom, tuition fee

£470 Non-resident: Lunch, supper, tuition fee

£670 International: Full board: ensuite bedroom, tuition fee

2. Complete the Booking Form on the TSG website and submit as instructed.
You will receive an automated copy of your application form by email.
Your completed details will be sent to the Booking Secretary.
3. You will be offered a place if available and sent full details of how to make a deposit to accept.
4. Payments are in pound sterling by BACS. Bank charges are your responsibility.
If you are unsure about BACS payments or emailing, please ask family/friends for help!
5. When your payment has cleared in the TSG bank account, you will be sent a confirmation letter.
6. If you cancel within 7 days, you will be refunded your deposit less 10%.

Terms and conditions

1. The Textile Study Group reserves the right to cancel the course.
In that circumstance, deposits and balances already paid will be refunded to each student.
2. Balance payment is due by **29 March 2022**. Please pay on time to confirm your reserved place.
3. Cancellation, after payment of the balance, must be notified by email to the Booking Secretary.

If your place is filled: Full refund of the balance will be made, less handling charge of £20

If your place is <u>not</u> filled:	Cancel	by	31 May	50% of the balance refunded
		by	9 July	25% of the balance refunded
		after	9 July	No refund

Any refund due will be paid **after** the start of the Summer School.

4. if you will receive an in-service grant from a college, please pay the Textile Study Group the deposit and balance by the due dates. Then claim a refund from your college.
